In this newsletter it is impossible to write down everything we saw and experienced. Signs and wonders followed everywhere we went.

His love was manifested for the people of Honduras as they cried out and hungered after God.

As we walked and stepped out in faith, doors were opened for us. The people opened their homes to us. Our days were kept busy as neighbors, friends, and family members would simply show up or come to get us to minister to loved ones. At night we were almost always scheduled for a service or crusade.



As we ministered in different churches, we found that more than half of the people did not know if they were saved. Even though there was a lot of praising and dancing, very few had received the baptism of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in other tongues. One of the churches asked us to speak to their leaders, a total of about thirty people. We were led to ask how many had received the Holy Spirit. We were surprised when only 2 or 3 responded. That night there was an outpouring of Gods Spirit and they were all filled.

In the churches we found many religious strongholds for lack of knowledge. Many had been taught that salvation was based on performance and works.

As the Word of God flowed out of our mouths, we would proclaim what the

Bible says

- "We are the righteousness of God in Christ and are seated in heavenly places with him"
- "All dominion and authority has been given to us through Christ Jesus"
- "There is no condemnation for those that are in Christ Jesus"

We received such joy when we would see the pastors and the people having their eyes of understanding opened and their minds renewed. It would reflect on their faces, like a light bulb being turned on.

In the morning we would have devotions at a restaurant in the hotel we were staying at for a few days. One morning we got into a conversation with our waitress and she ended up receiving the Lord. As we prayed for specific needs in her life the power of God fell upon her and after about ten minutes of praying for her we went back to our devotions. The next day she was still in awe about the experience and she shared with us what had happened. She said she saw four people praying for her and that one was a doctor that was fixing her up. Tom shared about Meshach, Shadrach and Abednego and she said that was just like in her vision. That day we had been scheduled to go to the prison and it was cancelled. Everything worked for good for we found out her daughter was at the prison and we were able to visit her when we went later. There were about 12 women and we were able to lead them to the Lord and pray for them.



Prison Ministry

I was in prison and ye came unto me Matthew 25:36



There have been many human right concerns about the over-population and conditions in the Honduran prisons.

Yet these are some of our favorite places to minister.

In this prison there had been a massacre that left sixty-four inmates dead several years ago.

There is usually someone from the church prison that escorts us in, but we walk in at our own risk, while the guards wait outside. The prisoners are sitting or standing in groups as we make our way through hundreds of inmates to our destination.

We took this opportunity to stop and talk to them, giving them literature concerning salvation, and inviting them to the service.

It was on one of these occasions we heard voices yelling “Gringos, Gringos, come here!” On approaching the voices, we saw what appeared to be a hole in the wall. It was there the troublemakers were punished and left for two or three months, depending on what they had done. We found five men in a very confined space, asking us to get them something to eat. Tom said that we did not have anything, for we were not allowed to bring in anything. He told them he did have something that was better than food. Manna from heaven. The power of God was so strong, they were captivated for forty five minutes as they listened to the salvation message. They all accepted Jesus and confessed him as their Lord and Savior. Later we prayed and they received the joy of the Lord.



As we ministered in their church prison, one inmate warned us to stay away from a group that calls themselves 666. As Tom started preaching, with Ruth translating, they gathered outside and started chanting. Tom did not hear them, he was focused on the message God had given him on the antichrist, and how the enemy is like a toothless lion, who makes noise, but has no teeth. He was right on! It was all noise! The power of God fell and many came to know the Lord.

At the prison in San Pedro Sulas, we experienced a mighty move of God. This prison has over two thousand inmates. Two or three years ago, one hundred-four inmates lost their lives in a fire due to gang rivalry. We always ask to visit with the isolated prisoners first, which are usually the troublemakers.



The inmate pastor escorted us to a gate that was opened for us. To our surprise, no one from the church prison went in with us.

The body language and tattoos said it all as they stood and looked at us.

It amazes us to see how the love of God can penetrate the hardest heart.



As we shared the good news with them, the love of God saturated them, and hearts of stone were changed to hearts of flesh. Afterwards, we ministered in the chapel where hundreds had gathered, of which about one hundred received salvation. Hundreds were baptized with the Holy Spirit and healed.

Outdoor Crusades

Many signs, wonders and healing were present wherever we went. This opened the doors to minister in different churches, as pastors heard of what was happening. At one of our first street crusades, people were laid out on the pavement and others were testifying how God had healed them.

A man waited one week, believing he was going to be healed from a stomach tumor. After prayer, he was immediately healed and testified to his miracle. On returning to his doctor, who refused to believe he was healed went ahead and sent him to his scheduled operation. After a presurgery exam, he was asked, "Why are you here?"



A lady with horrible headaches received instant healing from her pain that night.

One man came in on crutches, was healed, and left walking. He was so overwhelmed he broke down crying and the church was rejoicing for over an hour.



There were many more testimonies, including several of sight being restored.

To him that believes all things are possible. That was our message. Believe and come expecting a miracle in the name of Jesus.



The children are a big part of wherever we go. They are the first ones to be ministered to and prayed for. You must be like a child to enter the kingdom of heaven. We are so blessed as we see these little ones being touched by God.



Just In God's Time

On our way to visit the relatives of the family we were staying with, we had crossed two rivers, only to find a pick-up truck stranded with a flat tire needing help. Their jack was broken, it just so happens that God sent us there having an identical jack.

As the tire was being changed, Ruth asked them and several neighbors (who had gathered around), if they were saved. They all came to know the Lord as we prayed with them. The tire was fixed and we headed on our way. In the days that followed, we heard that two of the young men with the pickup had been killed in an automobile accident. We know it was a divine appointment and that they did not lose their lives, but now have eternal life.



Another elderly man we had witnessed to was the gardener at a church. Charles handed him literature concerning salvation, but he did not know how to read. So Charles read it to him, which asked if he were to die today, does he know without a doubt, he would go to heaven. The man replied he did not know. He was prayed with and accepted Jesus as his Savior. About a week later, he went to be with the Lord.

In total there have been four people who we led to the salvation knowledge of Jesus Christ before they have gone on to be with the Lord in heaven. Where would they be if we were not obedient to go?

In this news letter we could not begin to describe all the souls that were saved, healed, delivered, and set free, as God poured out of his Spirit. We experienced joy unspeakable, as we stood in awe of his glory.

Wherever we went, the word of reconciliation was proclaimed in Honduras!
